Our Micro-credentials are designed for people seeking employment, employees wanting to up-skill, industry professionals, novices and those of you who are somewhere in between.





RSA – Provide responsible service of alcohol (SITHFAB021)

ETC's RSA course covers all levels of sales personnel involved in the sale, service and promotional service of alcohol in licensed premises. Those selling and serving alcohol may include: food and beverage attendants, retail liquor sales persons, winery, brewery and distillery cellar door staff and supplier sales representatives.



Safe Food Handling – Use hygienic practices for food safety (SITXFSA005)

This course covers basic food safety practices such as personal hygiene and conduct, food handling, housekeeping and waste disposal.



Provide First Aid (HLTAID011)

This course describes the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to a casualty in line with first aid guidelines determined by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and other Australian national peak clinical bodies.



RCG – Provide responsible gambling services (SITHGAM022)

Responsible gambling services (RCG) must be provided wherever gambling activities are undertaken. In the hospitality industry, the gambling environment is usually referred to as the gaming area and is provided in a range of venues such as hotels, motels, clubs, pubs and casinos. The responsible provision of gambling services is an essential underpinning skill for all hospitality personnel involved in the sale and service of gambling activities in licensed premises.



Barista - Prepare and serve espresso coffee (SITHFAB025)

This hands-on course will help you develop your Barista skills. Safe Food Handling is a pre-requisite for this course.



Get Set 4 Hospitality (SITHFAB021, SITHGAM022, SITXFSA005)

Gain the skills & confidence to enter the hospitality industry with this practical 4-day program. Upon successful completion, you will gain your RSA, RCG plus Safe Food Handling skills and an introduction to barista skills.

Food Safety Supervision (SITSS00069)

Meet your legal requirements and protect your customers with ETC's Food Safety Supervision (FSS) course. By law, most Australian food businesses must employ at least one FSS in each premises. A FSS is a person who is trained to recognise and prevent risks associated with food handling in a retail food business and can train and supervise other people in the business about safe food handling. A FSS certificate must be renewed every 5 years.

Using discretion and judgement, they work with some independence and under limited supervision using plans, policies and procedures to guide work activities.
