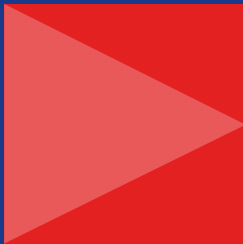
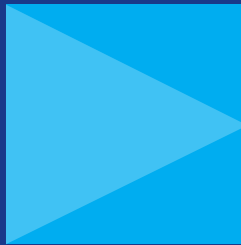
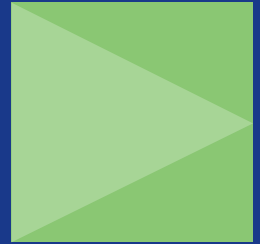

Delivery options are flexible and tailored to suit learners and employers, with availability varying by location.

Alongside formal qualifications, ETC provides targeted programs that remove barriers and open doors:

- **Skills for Education and Employment (SEE)**
– **Wivenhoe**: Foundation skills training

to build **language, literacy, numeracy and digital** capability, with classroom, workplace and remote options to suit life and work.

- **Workforce Australia - Career Transition Assistance (CTA)**: For **job seekers aged 45+**, CTA lifts confidence and digital skills, refreshes job search tools, and helps translate experience into compelling applications and interviews.
- **Workforce Australia - Self-Employment Assistance**: For people wanting to **start or grow a small business**. Support can include Exploring Self Employment workshops, business plan development, accredited small business training, **coaching** and **advice sessions**. (Eligibility applies; services are tailored.)
- **Skilling Queenslanders for Work (SQW)**: In Queensland, selected ETC programs run under **SQW** to build entry level skills and employability for eligible participants – including supported pathways into priority industries. (Subject to funding and eligibility.)

SITHFAB021

Provide Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA)

Responsible service of alcohol (RSA) course covers all levels of sales personnel involved in the sale, service and promotional service of alcohol in licensed premises. Those selling and serving alcohol may include: food and beverage attendants, retail liquor sales persons, winery, brewery and distillery cellar door staff and supplier sales representatives.



SITHGAM022

Provide Responsible Gambling Services (RCG)

Responsible gambling services (RCG) must be provided wherever gambling activities are undertaken. In the hospitality industry, the gambling environment is usually referred to as the gaming area and is provided in a range of venues such as hotels, motels, clubs, pubs and casinos. The responsible provision of gambling services is an essential underpinning skill for all hospitality personnel involved in the sale and service of gambling activities in licensed premises.



SITXFSA005

Safe Food Handling – Use hygienic practices for food safety

This course covers basic food safety practices such as personal hygiene and conduct, food handling, housekeeping and waste disposal.



SITHFAB025

Barista - Prepare and serve espresso coffee

This hands-on course will help you develop your Barista skills. Safe Food Handling is a pre-requisite for this course.



HLTAID011

Provide First Aid

This course describes the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to a casualty in line with first aid guidelines determined by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and other Australian national peak clinical bodies.

Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)

This course describes the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) Guidelines.

A FSS is trained to recognise and prevent risks associated with food handling in a retail food business they train and supervise other people in the business about safe food handling. *A FSS certificate must be renewed - please check with your state regulatory body for licensing requirements.*

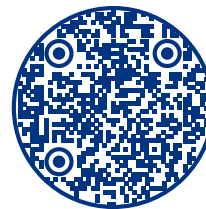

School-based apprenticeships and traineeships are more than just part-time jobs - they are a great way for students to set themselves up for a career while learning invaluable, real-life workplace skills and hands-on industry experience.

NSW - SBATs

School-based apprenticeships and traineeships (SBATs) are available to NSW Year 10, 11 and 12 high school students. They allow students to commence a traineeship or an apprenticeship while at school.

A school-based apprenticeship or traineeship combines paid work, training and school, and an industry-recognised national qualification. Plus, students can gain credit towards their HSC.

Some apprenticeships and traineeships can contribute towards the ATAR.

Course delivery

Courses can be delivered flexibly, on-the-job or off-the-job, through face-to-face, digital or blended delivery options. The SBAT term is calculated in months from the date of commencement to 31 December of the HSC year.

Commitment required

Students will need to undertake a minimum of 100 days in paid employment plus the formal training to complete the qualification.

The employment and training can be undertaken during school time, after school and during school holidays.

How will they be assessed?

Both on and off-the-job through written tests, project work and practical exercises.

QLD - SATs

School-based apprenticeships and traineeships (SATs) allow high school students (usually in Years 10, 11 or 12) to earn a wage, train towards a nationally recognised qualification and study towards their Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) at the same time.

Course delivery

Courses can be delivered flexibly, on-the-job or off-the-job, through face-to-face, digital or blended delivery options. Training can count towards final QCE credit points. Credits are based on the number of competencies (knowledge or skills learned in a workplace) a student completes and/or the number of hours they have worked.

Commitment required

Students are required to work at least 7.5 hours a week, averaged over every three months, for every 12 months of their training contract. For example, if students can't work during exams, they can work more hours during the school holidays.

How will they be assessed?

Both on and off-the-job the job through written tests, project work and practical exercises.
